**Park Shore Association -
Membership Renewal,
New Membership Application,
& Beach Park Sponsorship Opportunity**

Dear Park Shore Residents:

One of the many assets of the Park Shore Association is the community's private Beach Park located off of Gulf Shore Boulevard between LaMer and Provence Condominiums. The Beach Park is a wonderful amenity for all Park Shore Association members and has a positive impact on the value of our properties. Over the years, the Association has continually improved the appearance and function of the beach park with benches, landscaping, showers, etc.

In response to a significant number of requests from our members for restroom facilities at the Beach Park, your Board of Directors have unanimously voted to move forward in those efforts to meet that demand.

The restrooms to be constructed have been designed by a top-notch architect with experience in designing buildings in our neighborhood. The building will feature many security and design features such as key-card access locks, an attractive barrel tile roof, a recognition wall, and archways. Careful thought has gone into the design and placement of the building so as not to distract or diminish from the Park's current appearance or natural beauty. In short, the building has been designed to uphold the appearance, standards, and character expected of Park Shore.



In addition to the restroom facilities planned for the Beach Park, the Board has commissioned a "master plan" to be created for the park to provide for the incorporation and location of additional enhancements to the Beach Park should any be pursued in the future. These concepts such as a gazebo, picnic tables,

and other ideas were presented to you at our annual meeting in January 2007 and additional information has been relayed through our newsletter.

Needless to say, we've got some exciting plans in store for our Park. However, we need your help in seeing them through.

Therefore if you would like to make a contribution to help support our Beach Park (including the construction of the restrooms), or if you would like to provide a contribution in memory of a loved one, the Board would like to provide an opportunity for you to make an impact. We are also soliciting contributions from a variety of commercial partners we have enjoyed relationships with in the past. With these contributions towards the Beach Park project, we hope to minimally impact our association's annual dues. Construction of the restrooms can not begin until the Board has received a significant response from our membership.

This is YOUR opportunity to contribute to the construction of long-awaited restrooms at our beach park and make a lasting impact to your community.

Below is a schedule of contribution levels available. For most sponsorship levels, you will be given the opportunity to purchase a plaque with your name, or a memorial name, that will be mounted on a recognition wall at the Beach Park.

Contribution levels are as follows:

\$5,000 Platinum Sponsor - recognition in the Park Shore newsletter, a plaque with your name or a memorial name for the recognition wall, and a **lifetime** Park Shore Association membership.

\$2,500 Gold Sponsor - recognition in the Park Shore newsletter, a plaque with your name or a memorial name for the recognition wall, and a ten-year Park Shore Association membership.

\$1,000 Silver Sponsor - recognition in the Park Shore newsletter, a plaque with your name or a memorial name for the recognition wall, plus a five-year Park Shore Association membership.

\$500 Bronze Sponsor - recognition in the Park Shore newsletter, plus a one year Association membership.
